This is rather concerning. This document is part of ongoing research into the vaccination campaign in KZN. This document is a public record, as defined in the National Archives and records Service of South Africa Act.

As I'm sure you're aware, section 13(2)(a) of the same Act states that, "No public record under the control of a governmental body shall be transferred to an archives repository, destroyed, erased or otherwise disposed of without the written authorisation of the National Archivist".

an furthermore that, "Governmental bodies should also be aware that notwithstanding the provisions of any other Act of Parliament to the contrary (e.g. the Electronic Communications and Transactions Act, 2002) no electronic records may be deleted without a prior written disposal authority issued by the National Archivist."
